The full-time school program incorporates day-care for vour children as well as extensive individual educational options.

What do the full-time elementary schools offer?

- reliable care till 4 p.m. (free of charge)
- if needed additional early and late day-care from 7 a.m. till 5 p.m. (free of charge)
- participation up to 5 days per week
- homework support
- · your child will get to know the district's cultural institutions, sports clubs and more
- children can rely on regularly present educational staff
- vacation deals up to 9 weeks per school year (with costs)

What does the full-time elementary school offer your child?

- External partners offer you child various realms of experiences (i. e. sports, languages, cultural education, music etc.)
- Even in the afternoon teachers support your child while learning, i. e. with homework or while doing interesting extracurricular activities
- Your child has the possibility to relax after school: for example by going on dream journeys or by partaking in yoga classes for children
- Your child can spend time with friends or take part in chosen extracurricular activities
- Appointed care persons as well as the average number of 12 children per group provide a sense of security for the children

How does a good full-time school organize itself? EARNIN

- · The working basis of the full-time elementary schools is a common concept between the school, the cooperation partner and the City of Hanover
- The cooperation partners at the full-time schools are recognized youth welfare institutions
- The cooperation partners are chosen thoroughly
- The staff working at the full-time program is educationally qualified
- Parents, school principals, the school operator and the cooperation partner are working closely together


